

## Minutes, Cable Commission Meeting, February 26, 2018

Approval of minutes from the February 5, 2018 meeting. Motion made by Cory Spillar, seconded by Bruno Martins.

Nominations from the floor were requested for the position of Chairman of the Cable Commission and Cory Spillar nominated Lee Beckerman. No other nominations were received. Lee Beckerman is the Chairman of the Board.

The Cable Survey formulated by Lee Beckerman was reviewed and agreed upon and will be forwarded to John Hagerty.

As of yet there is no date firmed up for a Public Meeting.

The return date deadline was agreed upon as 30 days from the date of mailing the Sewer Bill. All Survey's will be mailed along with the Sewer Bill. In addition, the Survey will also be on the Woodbridge Township website for completion.

A cover letter to go along with the survey mailing which Mayor McCormac had penned was read and reviewed for content and accuracy and was approved by the committee to be sent out with the survey's.

A sub committee of Lee Beckerman, Joe Turant and Bruno Martins was formed to quantify the survey results and any complaints received in house or to the BPU. A request has been sent to the BPU for a record of their complaints received but as of yet they have not replied.

At this time the Meeting was opened to the Public. Seeing no one from the Public the Public portion of the meeting was closed.

Ryan L. Michelson formulated a letter to other Cable Providers asking if they would be interested in a parallel operation with Comcast. Lee Beckerman will provide certain statistics to be included in the letter and send same out.

A copy of the Cable Agreement from Edison is available from the administration and Lee Beckerman will take a look at it to see if there is any information that may be beneficial to us.

Lastly, it was discussed that when we sit down with Comcast we will ask that the YES channel be guaranteed so as to avoid the fiasco that we experienced this past year.

Cory Spillar made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 5:52 p.m. seconded by Bruno Martins.
