WPL to launch Hublet Stations with ARPA funds

WOODBRIDGE TOWNSHIP - Woodbridge Public Library has installed two Hublets, six-tablet vend stations to offer quick, in-house access to traditional and new library services. Hublets are portable tablet stations that dispense tablets preloaded with a wide range of digital content from newspapers and magazines to ebooks, games and apps, language learning software and online tutoring and courses. Library visitors scan their library card and the docking station releases a tablet for use anywhere within the wi-fi area.

Hublets are portable and will be hosted in the Main and Iselin locations of the library when they are not traveling to other Township locations for community engagement events.

The Hublet Launch is supported with funds provided by the Institute of Museum and Library Services, administered by the New Jersey State Library, award number LS-250226-OLS-21, administered by the New Jersey State Library.
